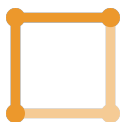

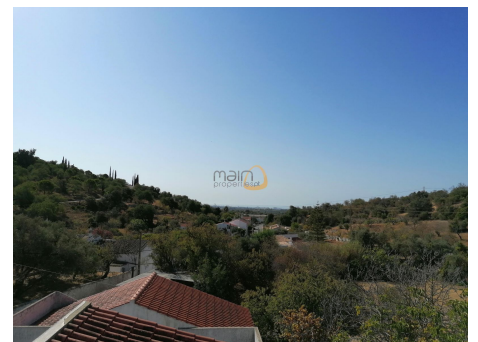

Description

This house has a total construction area of 638 sqm, inserted in a plot of land with about 3.500 sqm.

It also has an area of stables, orchard and own well.

Thus, this property is an excellent option for building a hotel for rural tourism.

Due to its extension area, it would be possible to build a hotel with about 20 rooms.

Which, for example, could be complemented with restaurant, outdoor pool, spa with indoor pool, a leisure space on the roof terrace with sea view, among many other options.

It would also be possible to transform this space into small rooms and a restaurant with local gastronomy, with the aim of monetizing the investment.

Finally, this could be your future family home, ideal for large families who privilege space, contact with nature, peace and privacy of this environment.

This is thus a house of Algarvian architecture with a high potential for recovery.

Located on the outskirts of Boliqueime, a very quiet and welcoming parish with easy access to the motorway.
